


# A Thousand and One Nights



## Wriezen, Germany—April 18th, 1945:

## BOARD CONFIGURATION:




**VICTORY CONDITIONS:** The Soviets win immediately by exiting 25 points off the west edge. Infantry = 1 point, Tanks = 2 points.




**Elements of 47th Army and 9th Guards Tank Corps (ELR 4) (No Sniper) Enter on Turn 1 on West edge of Board 44.**



**Elements of 606th Infantry and 111th Stug-Lehr Brigade (ELR 3) (No Sniper) Set up on Board 44 west of Row 6 and board 63 east of Row 3**



**Element Suleika 560th SS Tank Destroyer Battalion:**  
Enter on Turn 3 on the West Edge of Board 63 (ELR 4)

1. Wheat is not in season. Treat all wheat hexes as open ground.
2. German 50L AT Gun may bore sight.
