


Wasseburg Germany— May 2nd, 1945:

The 38th SS Nibelungen Division was reeling from repeated strikes from the US 20th Amored Division. On the morning of May 2nd, elements of the division set up an improvised defensive line on the outskirts of Wasseburg in an effort to halt the American advance.

Moving quickly, the confident recon elements of the 20th Armored slammed into the hasty defense with no intention of stopping.

BOARD CONFIGURATION:



VICTORY CONDITIONS: The Americans win immediately by exiting 25 points off the west edge. Vehicles =2 points, Full Squads = 1 point, and 1/2 Squads = 1/2 point.

Recon Elements of US 20th Amored (ELR 4) (No Sniper) Enter on Turn 1 on West edge of Board 1b.

Elements of 95th SS Panzer Grenadier Regiment and 38th SS Flank Battalion (ELR 3) (No Sniper) Set up East of Row AA on Board 1b.

SPECIAL RULES:

1. Wheat is not in season. Treat all wheat hexes as open ground..
2. US squads enter mounted on Turn1.
