
Now once more Schwoppe and his men must retake a village and restore the line.

Special Rules:

- 1. Place shell hole counters in these hexes: Y8, X8, X6, W5, V7, T7, T3, S5
- 2. Place rubble counters in these hexes: W4, Q4, P4, P2, O6
- 3. Place trench counter in these hexes: P7, P6, Q7, O5, O4, O3, (NOTE trench runs continuously through the rubble hexes)
- 4. Place wire counters in these hexes: P1, O2, O8, N6 (this represents the undestroyed wire from earlier German defenses)
- 5. No quarter rules are in effect.
- 6. The Soviets are able to utilize the captured German 50L, but the gun breaks on a 10 or better and cannot be repaired.
